

The most important feature here is the “Message” button, which you can use to send private messages to the user you have selected. (New messages can be accessed from the speech icon on the blue bar at the top of the screen.)



Chats – here you can enter a text-based chat with your entire class at a pre-arranged time. Chats take place in real time.



Forums – your tutor will use these to start discussions which all students are expected to contribute to. Forums are usually not in real time – you may be given a week or more to make a contribution.



Resources such as PDF files, powerpoints, word documents, images (all pictured here) or other types such as web-links and videos are available for download.



We will try to show the size of every file we make available so that you know how big a download it is going to be.



Instead of uploading videos, we will try as far as possible to link to Hugenote Kollege’s youtube channel, where you can choose what quality of video to watch depending on your internet connection.
